# Description

The eAr Academy offers world-class online music courses.

Interactive learning material includes videos, audio tracks, backing tracks, downloadable notation pdfs and unique, guided practice sessions. Tools include a built-in metronome and tuner.

The content covers a range of musical styles, including pop, rock, jazz, reggae, folk, Latin and blues. The approach is uniquely holistic, encompassing complementary facets of music, including Improvisation, Theory, and Ear Training. This approach gets students playing songs immediately and improvising early, and makes them more complete, more confident musicians.

Students get unlimited access to The eAr Academy so they can learn, practice and play as much and as often as they like.

The eAr Academy offers courses for six different instruments: piano, guitar, drums, electric bass, alto saxophone and trumpet. For each instrument, we have courses at Introductory Level, Level 1 and Level 2. The different levels cater for students at different skill levels, from absolute beginners to those with several years of playing experience. Students get full access to all three levels.

## Duration

Courses are for the duration of a year.

#### **Programme Requirements:**

Student will be required to have a device, either a computer or Tablet. They will also require an instrument to learn, practice and play on. The eAr will assist in selecting and buying an instrument if that is required. The only other requirement is curiosity and a love of music.

#### Students Responsibilities:

Music will one day be a part of your daily life - it probably already is, as you sing while you walk, sometimes quietly and sometimes out loud. Learning to play an instrument takes desire and commitment. It will take a bit of time, but you will surely get there, so the only responsibility is to commit to playing a couple of times a week.
